- Why do I need surgery?
- Is there some other way to treat my condition?
- What kind of surgery do I need?
- Have you done this surgery before?
- Which is the best hospital for this surgery?
- What do I need to do to prepare?
- How long will the surgery take?

- Does someone need to accompany me?
- Will I need anesthesia?
- How long will it take me to recover?
- How long will I be in the hospital?
- What can I expect after my surgery?
- Will I need special help at home?
- What will happen if I wait or don't have this surgery?
