  prohibited from redisclosing such information without my authorization unless permitted to do so under federal or
  state law. I understand that I have a right to request an accounting of disclosures of people who may receive or use

  AID/HIV testing/results, I may contact the New York State Division of Human Rights at (212) 480-2493 or the New York
  Commission of Human Rights at (212) 306-7450. These agencies are responsible for protecting my rights.
